With respect to previous Selection guidelines and Annexure-03, issued from this office (Ref-01) dated 14-09-2021, regarding age criteria, state NHM has appraised State Government Norms as described in KCSR rules 1977 (Ref-02) and considered the age relaxation factor for specific candidates with objective to provide fair chance to them under all the categories. Hence under this addendum NHM is considering age relaxation for below mentioned candidates as per the state norms (Ref-02).

Sl no	Candidates eligible for additional Age relaxation	Additional age relaxation for applying to post *	Remarks
1	Differently abled (e.g physically challenged etc)	10 years	These relaxations are over and above the maximum age consideration for the category under which the candidate is applying, (e.g For SC – Physically challenged person – maximum age for applying to CHO post is 40 +10 years. i.e 50 years)
2	Widow	10 years	
3	Bonded labourer (certified from Magistrate)	10 years	
4	Ex-serviceman	03 years plus the number of years of service rendered by him/her in the armed forces of the union.	

* The candidates availing the benefit shall produce valid certificate issued by the competitive authorities, other-wise their applications will be rejected without any notice and their selection will be cancelled.
